

Mona Baptiste

Mona Baptiste was a famous blues singer who was born on June 21, 1928. She was born in Port of Spain. Trinidad was 14 years old when she started singing on the radio and at dances, then she got involved in the Little Carib Theater. She immigrated to England in 1948 on the HMT Empire Windrush. One of the few women on the ship who had traveled first class, London began working towards her singing career shortly after.

Years later he appeared in British music magazine new musical express for events and appeared on the television program Colored Follies and appeared on the British radio variety show Brand Box in 1949. Baptiste was married to Michael Carle, whom he had met in London; After her death in a car accident in 1958 when her son Marcel was five years old, she retired. In 1972 she moved to Ireland, where she was her second husband, and in the 1970s she tried to return, but was unsuccessful.

After suffering a stroke, she died at age 65 on June 25, 1993 in Dublin, Ireland, where she had lived for several years with her second husband, Liam Morrison. She was buried in Deansgrange Cemetery.
