



Register your child for free school meals/2022/2023

Apply for Free School Meals if you are in receipt of one of the following Benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual household net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers' Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

If you receive benefits your child's school is also entitled to important additional funding called the 'Pupil Premium'.

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,345 for your child's primary school and £955 for your child's secondary school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.
