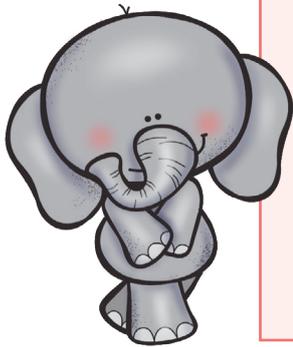


Making Inferences

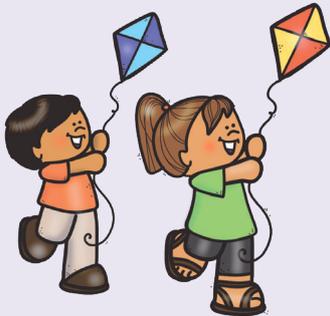

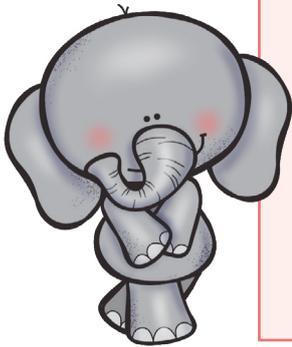
